

Buckland Parish Council – 2021/22 : Transparency Reporting : 10th May 2022

The Transparency Code sets out information local authorities in England with income or expenditure exceeding £200,000 are required to publish on either a quarterly or annual basis. Local authorities with income and expenditure of less than £200,000 but one or more of income or expenditure exceeding £25,000 are advised it is best practice to publish the information set out in The Transparency Code.

Buckland Parish applied best practice for the year 2020/21 and, for consistency confirms the following:

- Expenditure Exceeding £500
Council has chosen to publish a schedule that includes all ex-Vat payments exceeding £100 to maintain year to year consistency of reporting. The schedule for the full year is now available to download from the village website.
- Government Procurement Card transactions
As Buckland Parish Council does not use a Government Procurement Card there is no information to publish.
- Procurement Information
As Buckland Parish Council does not have any legally enforceable agreements with a value exceeding £5,000 there is no information to publish.
- Local Authority Land
As Buckland Parish Council does not hold legal title to any land or buildings and has not entered into any leases there is no information to publish
- Social Housing Assets
As Buckland Parish Council does not hold any social housing stock there is no information to publish
- Grants to Voluntary, Community and Social Enterprise Organisations
Buckland Parish Council has not awarded any grants during the 2020/21 financial year.
- Organisational Chart
Buckland Parish Council has only one employee, the Clerk, who also serves as Council's Responsible Officer. Its organisational chart has only one point of contact and anyone wishing to engage with Council is asked to contact the Clerk.
- Trade Union Facility Time
As Buckland Parish Council does not have any staff members who are union representatives there is no information to publish.
- Parking Account
As Buckland Parish Council has no chargeable parking there is no information to publish.
- Parking Spaces
As Buckland Parish Council does not have any controlled car park spaces there is no information to publish.
- Senior Salaries
As Buckland Parish Council does not have any staff member whose salary is £50,000 or greater there is no information to publish.
- Constitution

- Pay Multiple
As Buckland Parish Council's only employee is the Clerk, its Pay Multiple is one.
