Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL)
Annual Report 2021/22

Introduction

1. Regulation 62A of the Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) Regulations 2010, requires local councils to report about CIL receipts, expenditure and balance. Local councils receive CIL money via Meaningful Proportion, which takes place twice a year. This sees local councils receiving a percentage of any CIL money paid within their parish/town.
2. The report must be completed no later than 31st December following the reported year.
3. The report must be published either on the local council's website or on the website of the charging authority if the local council does not have a website.
4. A copy of the report must also be sent to the charging authority.
5. In order to ensure that all local councils have complied with the requirement, Buckland Parish Council will publish a report annually on its website which covers the points raised by Regulation 62A to ensure complicity and ease of access of information.
6. This report relates to the financial year 2021/22 ("the reported year")

2. Buckland Parish Council received money via Meaningful Proportion during the financial year.
